

FAQ: ALL THINGS AP TESTING

2021 AP exams will be administered from Monday, May 3 - Monday, May 17 (Exception: No exams will be given on Thursday, May 13th).

Q: How do I change from a F2F exam to Digital exam? Registration is closed for 2021 AP exams.

A: Log into your College Board account, and review chosen exam format (on your AP dashboard), if a student wants to change testing format from face-to-face (May exams) to digital (June exams), please email Monica White at whiteml@fultonschools.org immediately. There is no fee for this change. However, the change must be done 7 days prior to the exam date.

Q: How do I update my email on my College Board account?

A: Log in to your College Board account to update email address. Be sure that you have an updated personal email address listed on your College Board account; FCS student emails expire after graduation.

Q: I do not want to take AP exams. How do I cancel my exams?

A: College Board has waived fees for the cancellation of 2021 AP exams. If you want to cancel your AP exams, please email Ms. White as soon as possible.

Q: Where will I take my exams?

A: Locations for most exams are the Main Gym, Auxiliary Gym, 6213 AND 6214. Testing dates, times, and locations will be posted throughout the building, in the Eagle Update, and on the school website. Some students may receive testing information individually.

Q: What time do exams start each day?

A: Exams start times are 8:00 am, 12:00 pm, and 2:00 pm each day. Most exams are 2-3 hours long.

Q: What time should I report to my testing location?

A: Students must report to exam locations 30 minutes prior to the start of exams. Own transportation must be provided to and from school during exam days.

Q: What do I bring to school on exam day?

A: Be sure to bring the following: pencils, pens, and approved calculator. Snacks and bottled water can be enjoyed during testing break outside of testing location.

Q: What NOT to bring on exam day?

A: DO NOT bring backpacks into the testing locations. DO NOT bring wearable technology (smartwatches, fitness trackers), phones, or any other type of electronic or communication devices into the exam locations.

AP Digital Exams: All digital exams (June 1- June 11) have synchronous start times worldwide, and automatically begin at the same official state time everywhere: 12:00 pm and 4:00 pm (EST).
