

WORK-BASED LEARNING (WBL) INFO

Attention rising Juniors and Seniors - you are now possible eligible for Work-Based Learning (WBL). The WBL Program includes Traditional WBL 1&2 hour, Teacher Assistants, Medical Interns (specialized program for medical students only), and Media Center Assistant Tech Eagles.

The WBL Application for 2020-2021 is the same for all areas and are in the Counseling Suites starting 1/23 for student pickup and will be due Thursday, 2/6 before Noon in Office 1245. Applications are not accepted at any other time of the year.

WBL Application Drop Off and Help Hours (note times): are during the application time period with Dr. Wagner, running Jan 23 through Feb 5 from 8AM till 8:45AM and Feb 6th from 8AM till Noon in Office 1245. The application process will determine if students meet the guidelines for the WBL program.

Traditional 1&2 Hour WBL PROGRAM 2020-2021

WBL Traditional is a year-long paid or unpaid internship/work experience with mentoring and supervision with a 1 or 2 hour school early release/late report. You must have completed 1 course in ANY pathway (Advanced Academics, Business, Computing, Fine Arts, Engineering, etc.) to be eligible for WBL. You do not have to have a job or internship secured to sign up for the class, but you must have one secured no later than June 30, 2020. Pick up applications from Counseling Suites starting 1/23. Applications must be submitted to Dr. Wagner, Office 1245, by Noon, Thursday, February 6. Applications are not accepted at any other time of year.

TECH EAGLE WBL PROGRAM 2020-2021

Milton's Media Center Assistant Tech Eagle program is part of work-based learning (WBL). This position works in the media center assisting primarily with operational tasks. Students also assist with student learning device functions playing a key role in the digital revolution at Milton.

Here are the basics:

- Rising juniors and seniors who have completed or are enrolled in a Computer Science course must apply during the WBL application period.
- Pick up applications from Counseling Suites starting 1/23.
- Applications must be submitted to Dr. Wagner, Office 1245, by Noon, Thursday, February 6. Applications are not accepted at any other time of year.
- The Media and Education Technology Instructor/s will select from interested candidates through an interviewing session.
- Media Center Assistant Tech Eagle associates must commit to a year-long term of service.

- Media Center Assistant Tech Eagle associates will be enrolled in a WBL course and will be assigned to a Media and Education Technology Instructor mentor meeting every day of the school year.
- The Media and Education Technology Instructor mentor will serve as the Milton's Media Center Assistant Tech Eagle mentor and will complete 3 evaluations per semester regarding on-the-job performance.

TEACHER ASSISTANT PROGRAM WBL 2020-2021

Milton Teacher's Assistant (TA) program is part of work-based learning (WBL). We see the TA as an additional resource in our move to enhance personalized learning.

Here are the basics:

- Rising juniors and seniors who have completed or are enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP)-related course must apply during the WBL application period.
- Pick up applications from Counseling Suites starting 1/23.
- Applications must be submitted to Dr. Wagner, Office 1245, by Noon, Thursday, February 6. Applications are not accepted at any other time of year.
- The potential Instructor/s will select from interested candidates through an interviewing session.
- TA's must commit to a year-long term of service.
- TA's will be enrolled in a WBL course and will be assigned to a specific classroom teacher to serve as a TA each day of the school year.
- The specific classroom teacher will serve as the TA's mentor and will complete 3 evaluations per semester regarding the TA's on-the-job performance.
