

SENIOR EXAM INFORMATION

Exemption Policy

- Must have a 90 or above (not including honors points)
- No ISS or OSS for 2nd semester
- **Can't exempt an EOC course**

Attendance will be taken, and disciplinary actions will continue through the end of the school year. If students acquire **unexcused absences**, they may be referred to administration who will administer consequences. Consequences may include ISS, which will result in the loss of a student's exemption privilege. Any student absences need to be supported with documentation (either complete the Parent Permission Google Form below, or students need to bring in a parent/doctor note.)

AP testing starts May 6th, and we understand students MAY NOT be in class because they will be taking an AP exam. AP exam attendance will be taken daily and entered by the attendance clerk.

If there is a conflict between an AP exam and a final exam, STUDENTS MUST REPORT TO THEIR AP EXAM, and reschedule their final exam with their teacher.

Make-up exams will be available 5/14, 5/15, 5/16, 5/17. **We will have people available in the Media Hub for students to take make-up final exams.**

Seniors will be notified, by their teacher, on **Friday, May 3rd** if they are able to exempt their final.

Senior exams will be taken during their normal class period – 55 minutes
