

WORK-BASED LEARNING (WBL) Areas Available **2024-2025 School Year**



TRADITIONAL WBL PROGRAM - is a year-long paid or unpaid internship/work experience with mentoring and supervision with an early school release/late report schedule. You must have completed one course in ANY pathway (Advanced Academics, Business, Computing, Fine Arts, Engineering, etc.) to be eligible for WBL. You do not have to have a job or internship secured to sign up for the class, but you must have one secured no later than June 30th. Please complete the WBL Application Launch form open from Jan 12 through Jan 29th NOON to start the application process. Applications are not accepted at any other time of the year.

TEACHER ASSISTANT PROGRAM - is part of work-based learning (WBL) and is seen as an additional resource in our move to enhance personalized learning. Please complete the WBL Application Launch form open from Jan 12 through Jan 29th NOON to start the application process. Applications are not accepted at any other time of the year. Here are the basics:

- Rising juniors and seniors who have completed or are enrolled in an Advanced Placement (AP) or related level course.
- Potential Instructor/s will select from interested candidates through an interviewing session.
- TA's must commit to a year-long term of service.
- TA's will be enrolled in a WBL course and will be assigned to a specific classroom teacher to serve as a TA each day of the school year.
- The specific classroom teacher will serve as the TA's mentor and will complete evaluations regarding the TA's on-the-job performance.

MEDICAL INTERNSHIP PROGRAM - (specialized program for medical students only) - is part of work-based learning (WBL) and in conjunction with the Medical Programs offered at MHS. Students will be required to gain approval to enter the Med Internship program by (Baule/Kleimon/or transcript) showing pre-req courses acquired. Students work in the medical environment during their internship hours. Internships are year-long paid or unpaid internship/work experience with mentoring and supervision with an early school release/late report schedule. You do not have to have a job or internship secured to sign up for the class, but you must have one secured no later than June 30th. Please complete the WBL Application Launch form open from Jan 12 through Jan 29th NOON to start the application process. Applications are not accepted at any other time of the year.

The WBL Application for 2024-2025 is the same for all areas with the launch form open from Jan 12 through Jan 29th NOON. Applications are not accepted at any other time of the year. Please make sure to use your student FCS login to access the launch form that begins the online process. The application process will determine if students meet the guidelines for the WBL program.
