

FINAL EXAM EXEMPTION POLICY

Student exemptions are intended as an academic incentive.

Students in grades 9 through 12 **in semester courses ONLY** are able to exempt fall exams.

The following guidelines determine exemptions:

- **No days of ISS or OSS**
- 90+ average (Honors/AP points **EXCLUDED**)
- End of Course Tests may not be exempted

Teachers inform students of their exemption status on the Friday prior to the week their final exams are scheduled.

Q & A

- **What grade levels can exempt?** All grade levels.
- **How many semester exams may be exempted?** As many as the student is eligible to exempt.
- **Can I exempt first semester exams?** Only if it is a one semester course.
- **Can I exempt an End of Course test?** No. The EOC is a state-mandated exam.
- **Can I exempt a semester exam in an AP course?** Only if you meet the eligibility requirements.
