TELESCHOOL LEARNING

INFORMATION

TeleSchool is a strategy for learning continuity to be deployed for extended time away from school. Students will need to follow the below schedule while Fulton County/Milton High School is closed. The expectations for subject work and duration for students is as follows:

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PROM 2020 INFORMATION

As we are all aware, Fulton County Schools has closed until further notice. Due to this mandatory closure, we cannot move forward with prom as previously scheduled; prom for March 28, 2020 has been

CANCELLED.

We are very committed to still providing your students with a prom experience; therefore, we have a new tentative date for prom to be held at Milton High School (similar to Homecoming) on April 18, 2020.
