Maryam Jami received her Bachelor's in Law with Honors from Herat University in Afghanistan. She has completed coursework in International & Comparative Law and Human Rights Law from the University of Leiden, University of London, Princeton University, and Harvard University. Maryam was a researcher at the Institute of War and Peace Studies, was the legal adviser for International Bridges to Justice and Jesuit Refugee Services in Afghanistan and Masnad Legal Consultancy, and performed legal research for Afghanistan Human Rights and Democracy Organization and Ritsona Refugee Camp. She is also widely published, having written in numerous journals in the five languages she speaks.



Oleh Kornat (Ukraine) received his Bachelor's and Master's of Law from Lviv National University in Ukraine. He has worked as legal counsel for Lviv National University, a legal specialist for Lviv Service Delivery Center, Legal Counsel for a financial company, and a junior associate for Lavrynovych & Partners.
