I’m reminded of the Apostle Paul’s declaration to the Church in Rome found in his gospel letter...*Romans 5:3,5 (TPT): “ Even in times of trouble we have a joyful confidence, knowing that our pressures will develop in us patient endurance...⁵ because we can now experience the endless love of God cascading into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who lives in us!”*

A family who has been with us for the past five years has been going through a life altering experience. Jim, a truck driver, was transported from an Abilene hospital on December 13, 2019 to UMC in Lubbock with a perforated bowel and is still in the hospital. After three months in ICU and eight surgeries later Jim and his family are living, trusting and believing God is sufficient for all their needs.

God’s family has come along side to help share in the burden they are experiencing.

What a joy it is to see and participate with Christ’s Church who has stepped up and stepped into action living out Acts 2 with Jim and his family. Although Jim remains in the hospital our fervent prayer is God will heal and raise him up!

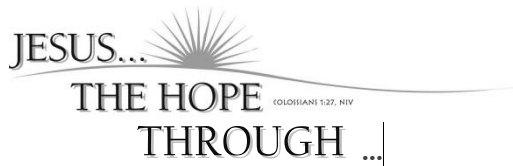

Last year Grayson, brand new to our church, had a speaking part in the musical. The day of the musical, Grayson's mom, aunt and grandma attended the musical to proudly watch Grayson. They were so struck by the friendliness of the church and the openness to love all people that his aunt and Grandma began attending. Since that time, they have joined the church, and his aunt especially has gotten involved in Bible studies, Sunday school, worship ministry and mission opportunities. This year has been a year of transformation in her life as his aunt has completely dedicated her life to the Lord. Through her transformation, she is now reaching her estranged husband who is lost, and Grayson's mother has started attending a Bible study. God is so good!

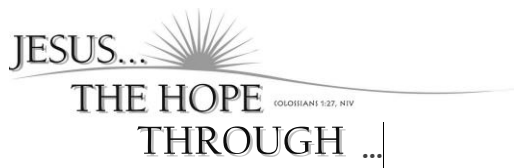

In October of 2019 a member of our church, Sherri Dudick, began to feel a burden to provide food for our community. Our facility will not accommodate a food pantry at this time and with that in mind, Sherri began to explore other possibilities. After meeting with the Tarrant Area Food Bank it was suggested that we become a host for their mobile distribution program. It was a perfect fit for us! On the 1st Saturday of every month a truck from the Food Bank pulls in with 20,000 pounds of food.

After it is unloaded an army of CrossPoint volunteers breaks down the palletted food and organizes it on a line of tables. After a brief intake meeting our neighbors walk by the tables collecting what they need. Saturday, March 7th, was our 4th distribution and CrossPoint distributed 20,000 pounds of food to 158 families representing almost 750 people! We've connected with several families and have been able to minister beyond the food line. We praise God for the vision and tenacity of Sherri and for her army of volunteers!

We continued to grow once-defunct Neighborhood Association we re-launched. And when the nearby elementary school received an "F" rating from the Texas Education Association, the principal asked us to start a literary program to raise first graders reading levels. We brought in 15 community volunteers to serve in the school each week.

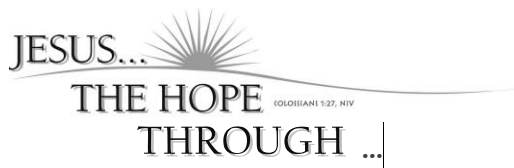

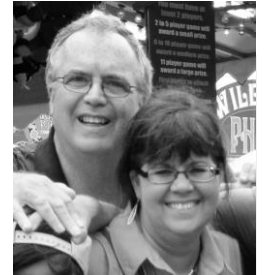

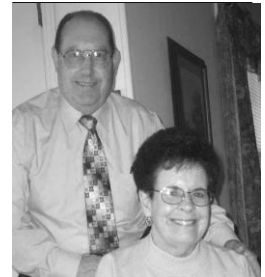

Crisis Care Kits have made a comeback. We have collected the banana boxes and stacked them on the platform as a reminder to bring items to fill the bags and boxes.

During morning worship, as the announcements are being given, we encourage people to write down a “thank you” on a colored strip of paper (handed out as the people enter worship). The papers are then collected in a see-through plastic jug. (Use different colors of the bright paper, 5½ x 1 ½ inch strips.) We did this until the jug was full. Each Sunday, during our worship service, we read some of the papers as a “living thank you to God”.

Food boxes and food access seem to be covered in our area, however, we were really surprise when we participated in the community sponored “Clothes Panty”, how many people needed basic clothing items. Volunteers work 3-4 days a week sorting and providing free clothes for anyone who needs them. More than 6,000 people were served in our area.

Financially every small church struggles to meet the pastor’s salary and fixed expenses each month. This year we took action and contacted a local Farmer’s agent to handle our church insurance. Our premium dropped 40% and included some additional items we had not considered before.

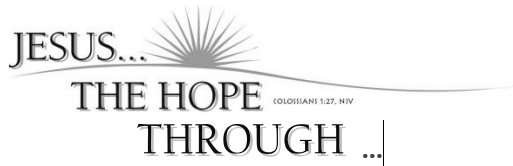

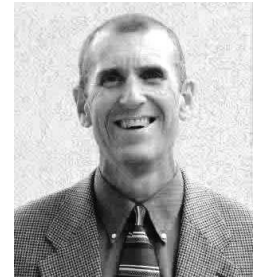
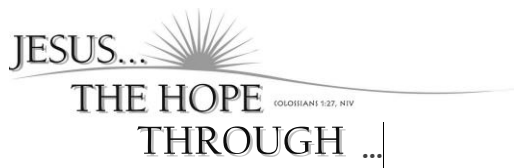
