

PQA Measure Development Team 16 (MDT 16): Objectives and Selection Criteria

The objective for the PQA MDT 16 is to develop specifications for a measure concept evaluating appropriate medication use to prevent cardiovascular outcomes in persons with diabetes. This measure concept is intended for health plan performance comparisons.

Preference will be given to applicants who:

- Have relevant clinical expertise and experience in diabetes management, cardiovascular disease;
- Represent an organization with interest in/programs that evaluate diabetes outcomes;
- Have measure development experience;
- Understand administrative claims data that would be needed to calculate the measure; *and/or*
- Possess analytic expertise.
