



TN PASRR TRANSITION: *The Basics*

All PASRR Level I and II assessments must occur prior to nursing facility admission per federal regulation

WHAT will change

PASRR Level I screens will be completed in the Ascend PASRR web application



For individuals requiring PASRR Level II, Ascend will review level care as a part of the evaluation



WHO is affected & should stay informed

HOSPITALS: Administrators, Discharge Planners, Case Managers, Social Workers, Nurses, and anyone involved in transitioning persons to NF placement

NURSING FACILITIES: Administrators, Social Services, admissions staff, care planning staff

AAADs: Those involved in referring Medicaid-eligible persons for NF admission from the community

MCOs: Those involved in referring Medicaid recipients for NF admission from the community
