The Texas Telephone Association recently awarded \$48,000 in four-year scholarships to six Texas high school students entering college in the fall 2018 semester, including Wesley Sanders of Lexington High School. Wesley will be attending Texas A & M University and plans to major in Business.

“Education is a critical issue for the Texas telecommunications industry and the communities we serve,” said Bill Colston, Jr. of Riviera Telephone Company Inc. and chairman of the TTA Foundation.

The TTA foundation is a non-profit, philanthropic organization founded to help further the understanding of telephony and advance telecommunications as a career choice.

To be eligible for a TTA Foundation scholarship, students must have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher and be planning to attend a Texas college or university in fall 2018.
