

Slay your Midterm Essay!

Schedule it → Plan when you will complete what sections each day leading up to the deadline. Leave the day before it's due as an 'editing day'.

Write an outline → This can be the focus of one of the days you set time aside to work on the essay

3 Quotes → Have a list of at least 3 quotes you can use in the paper.

Cite → your sources before you start working so it's easier to remember to embed them in the text.

2 editors → Have at least 2 people look over your essay. I recommend one person who is in the class and one person who is not.

Flow → Have a sentence at the beginning and end of each paragraph that connects it to the latter or future section.
