- There are plenty of seats for people to come in person to celebrate - NO tickets required!



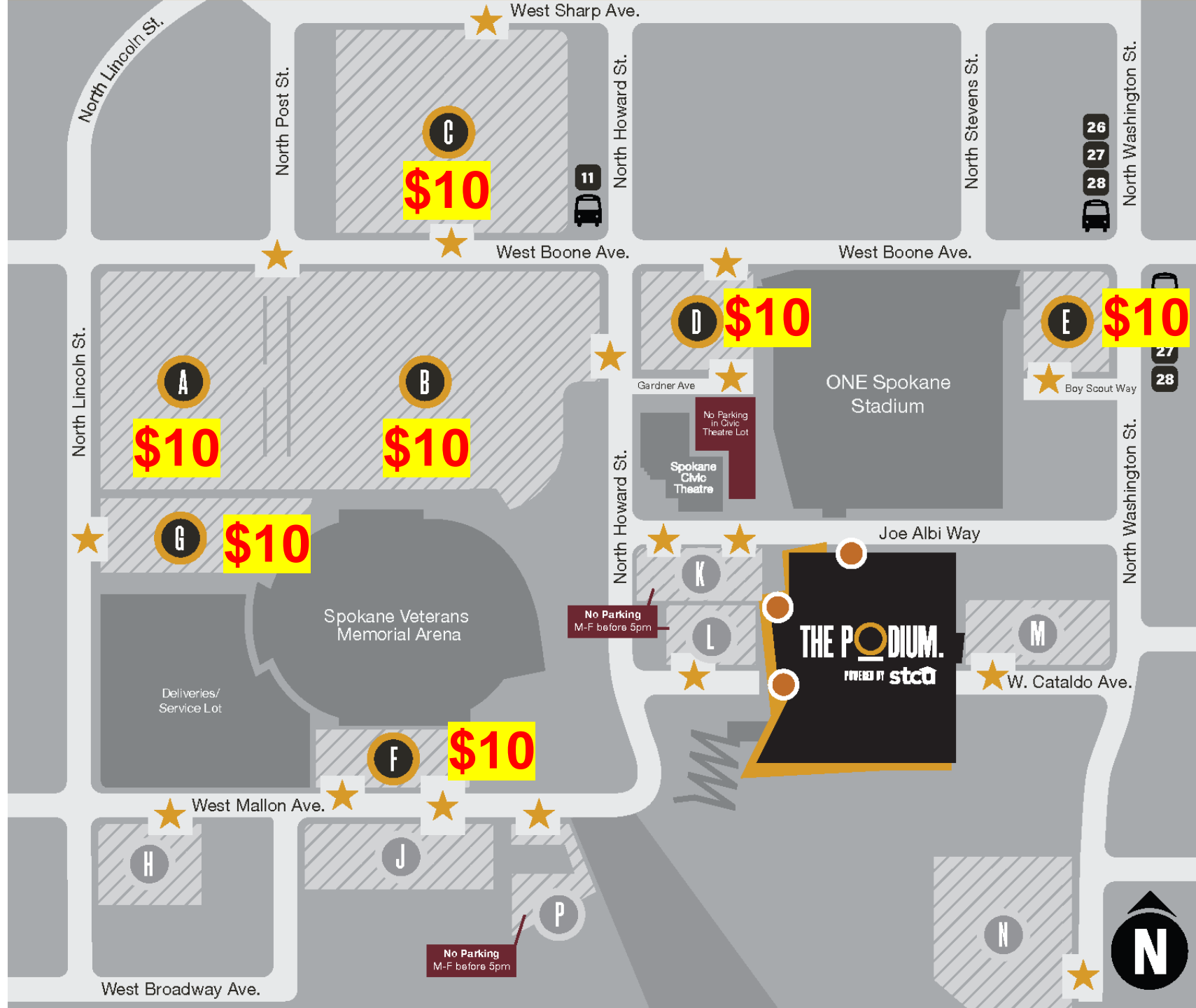


PARKING

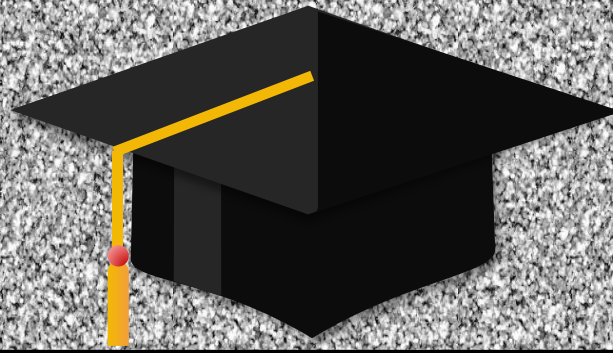

WHAT TO BRING

- Yourself - doors open at **10:00am**! Be there at **10:00am**!
- Cap, Gown, Tassel, Cords, Stoles, & Medals
 - We suggest that you hang up your gown ASAP so the wrinkles will release
- Suggested clothing
 - Graduation is a formal event, please dress accordingly. Don't wear t-shirts, jeans, shorts.
 - Dress like you would for an important interview.
 - Shoes - highly suggested to **NOT** wear spiked heels (the floor is grooved and has small holes)





WHAT NOT TO BRING

- After the ceremony, you will directly exit the Podium, so there isn't a place to store any items that you can't carry in your pocket under your gown (we will not be returning to the set-up area).
- Do **NOT** bring:
 - Bags, backpacks, purses, yearbooks, etc.
 - Noisemakers, silly string, beach balls, costume, signs, etc.
- **You do not want to distract from the ceremony - this event is about the whole group, not individuals.**

ARRIVAL

- Enter through the North doors (the main entrance)
- Doors open at **10:00am**
- Go through security and head downstairs



LINING UP BACKSTAGE

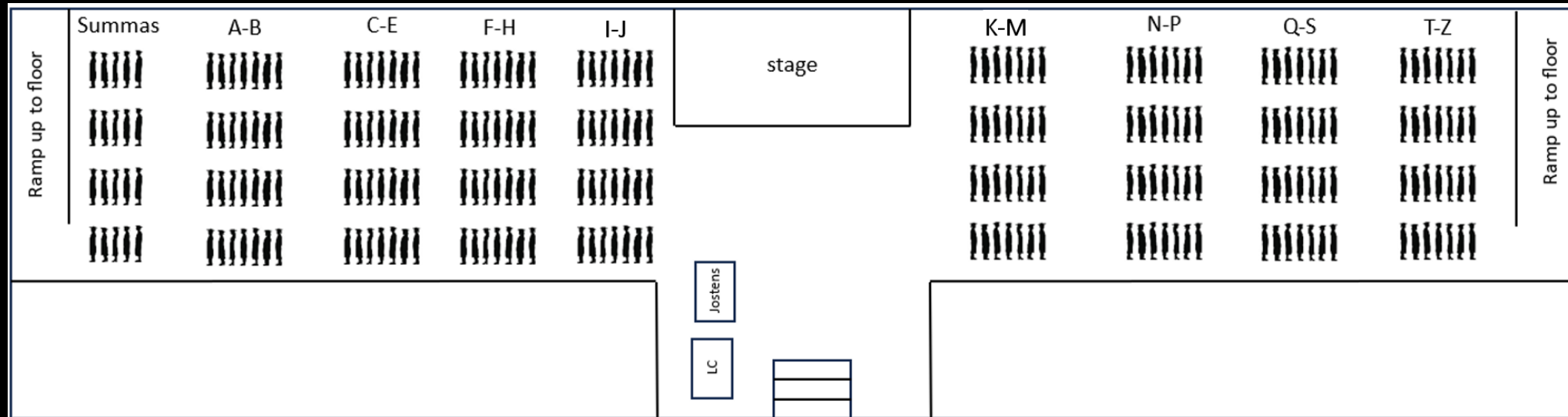
- After you go through security, head down the stairs to the staging area
- Look for an LC staff member carrying a sign with the letter corresponding to your last name
 - Check in and take your name card
 - Begin lining up in alpha order by last name, stay with your group
 - **Summas & A-J** go left and **K-Z** goes right

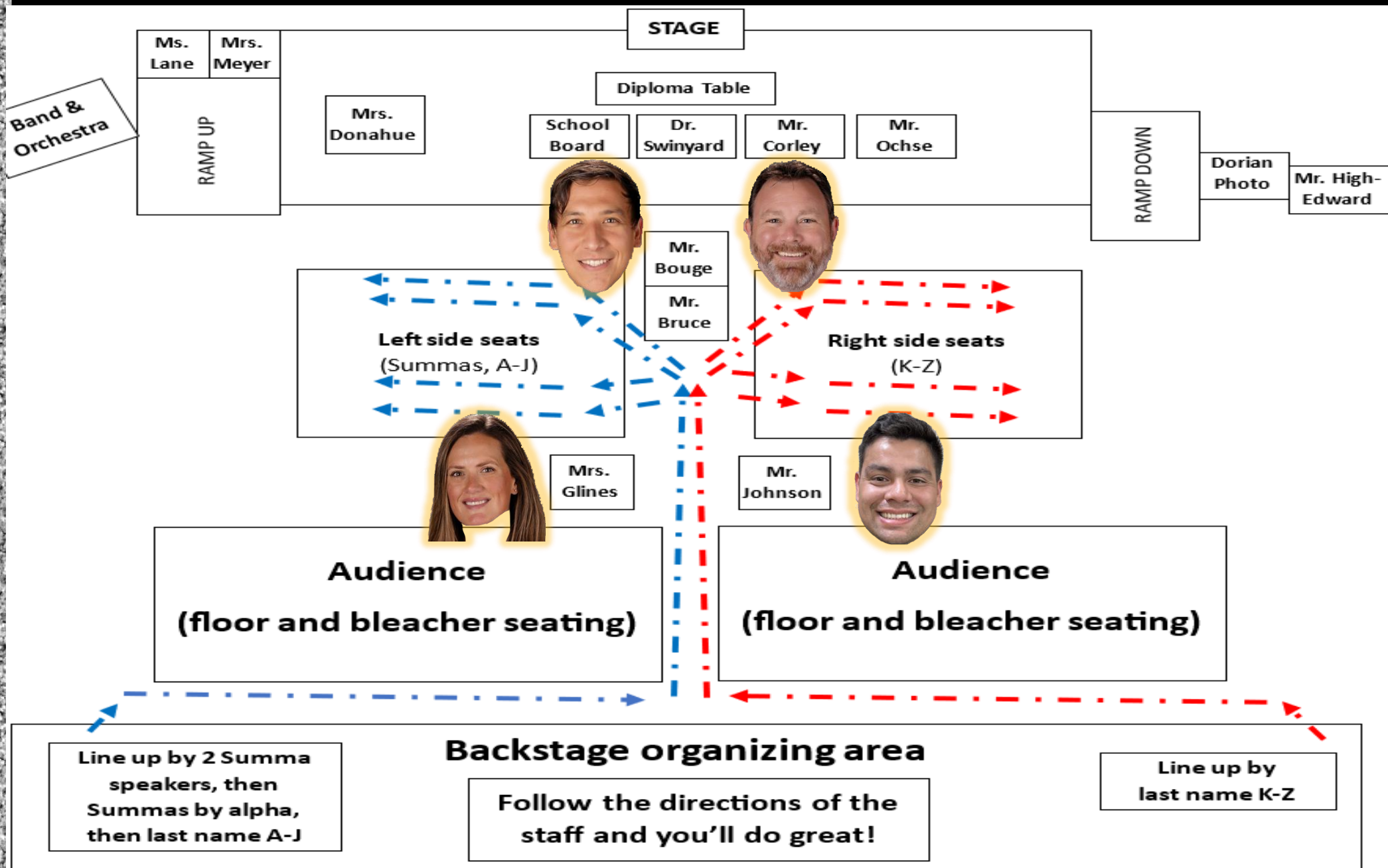
SHOW TIME!



- When “Pomp and Circumstance” begins, LC staff will let you know it is time to march in.
 - Stay at a nice even pace (with a few feet between you and the person ahead of you).
- Follow the leaders of each side, march to the middle of the floor and then both rows will come together and march side by side (don’t mix the sides!) up the middle aisle.
- Move into your assigned row and stay **STANDING** until you are told to sit.

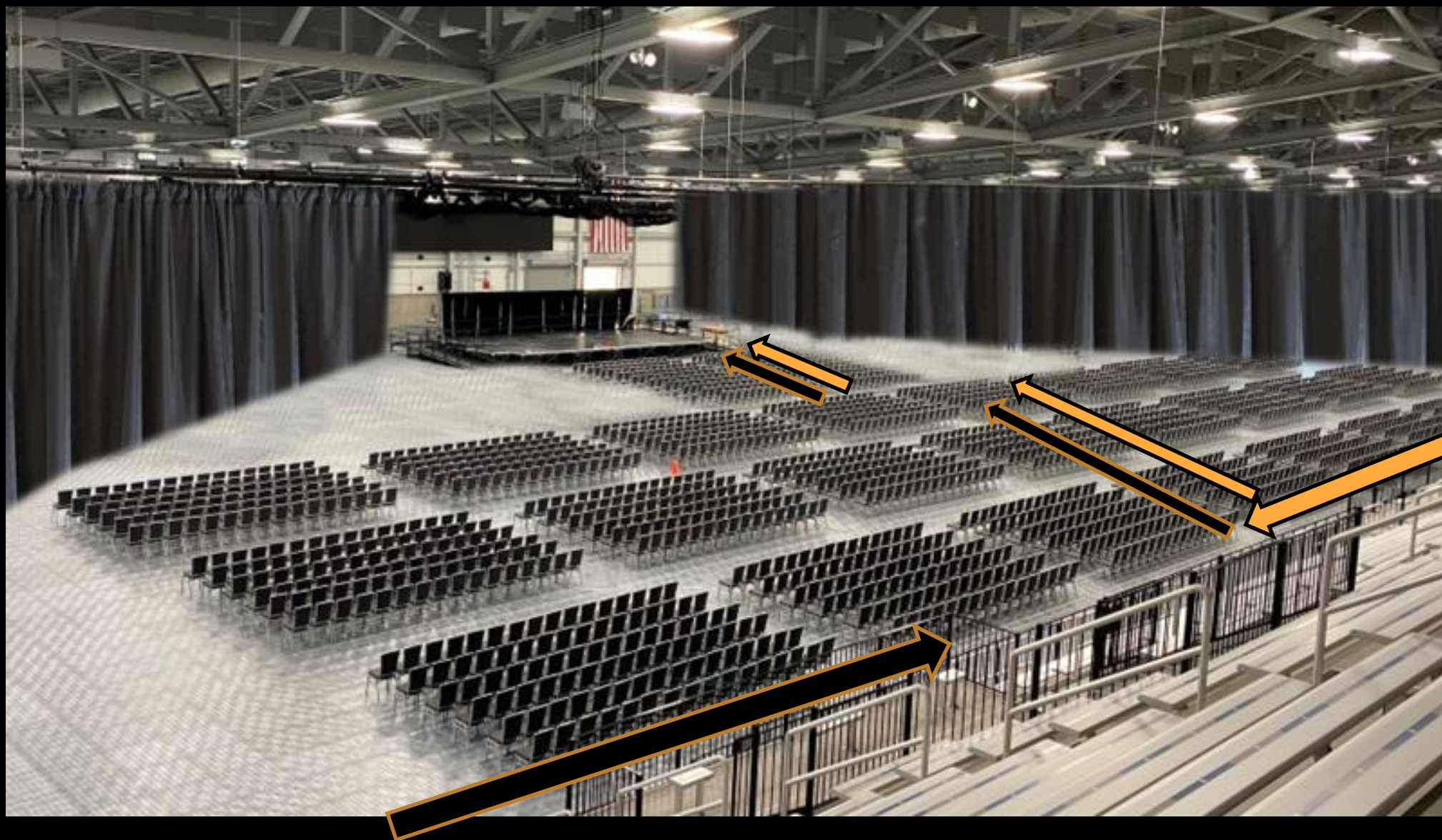

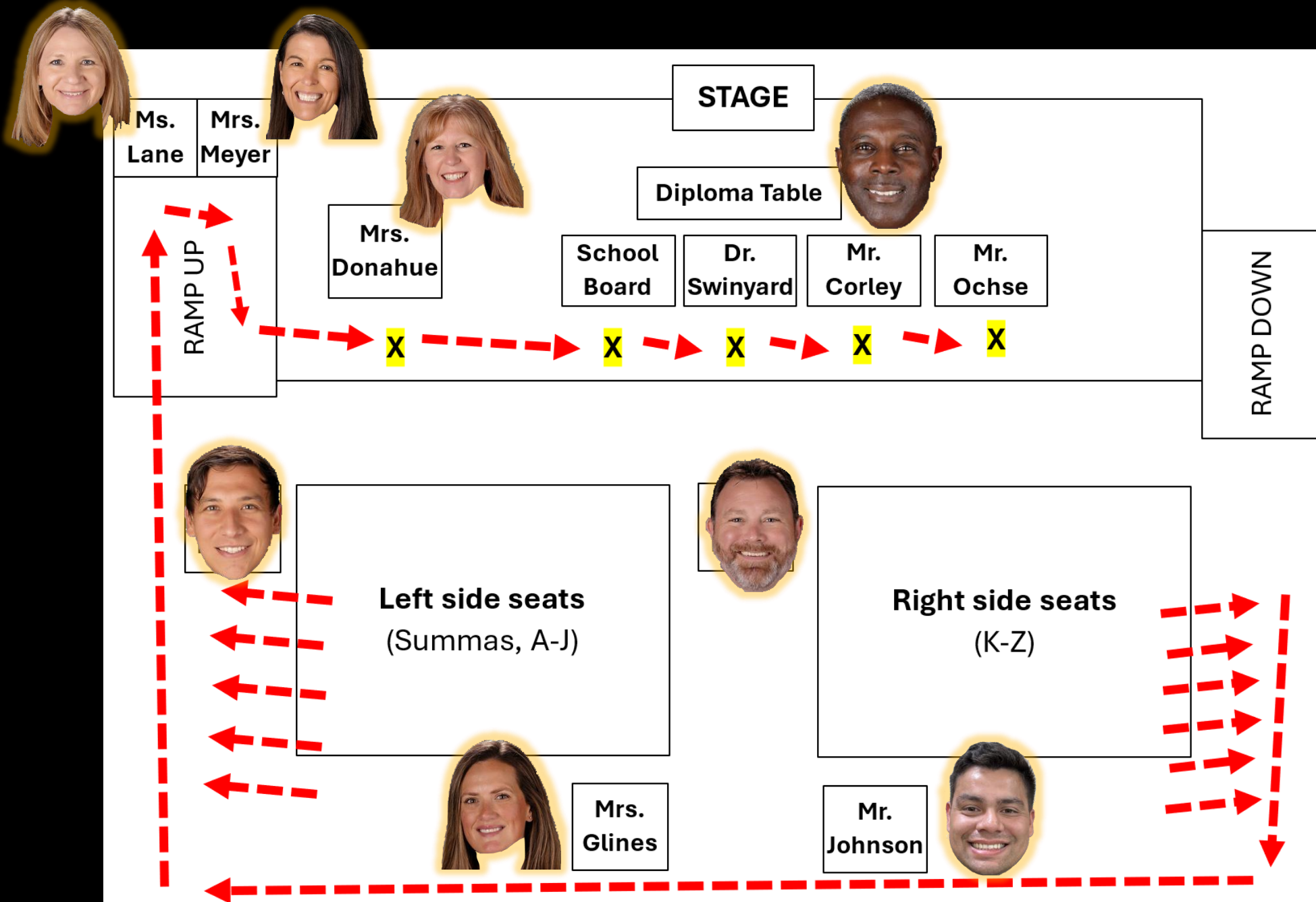


HEADING TO THE STAGE

- The most important thing you need to do is **watch for Mr. Bruce & Mr. Bouge** to give your row the signal to stand up.
- We'll start on the Summa/A-J side first.
- K-Z, stay seated until you are directed to begin your side.
- Ms. Lane & Mrs. Meyer will be at the top of the ramp to make last minute adjustments to your cap and cords.
- Have your name card out and in your hand ready to give to your reader.

YOUR MOMENT IN THE SUN

- School Board member Hilary Kozel, Superintendent Dr. Swinyard, Mr. Corley, & Mr. Ochse will all be there to shake your hand.
- Take your diploma cover from the school board member with your LEFT hand & shake with your RIGHT hand (under the diploma).
- After greeting all 3 people, keep walking to exit the stage where you will stop to take an official picture.
- Mr. High-Edward, Mr. Johnson, Mrs. Glines, Mr. Bouge, & Mr. Johnson will direct you back to your seats. Stay standing until your entire row returns (they'll signal you to sit).

YOUR MOMENT IN THE SUN

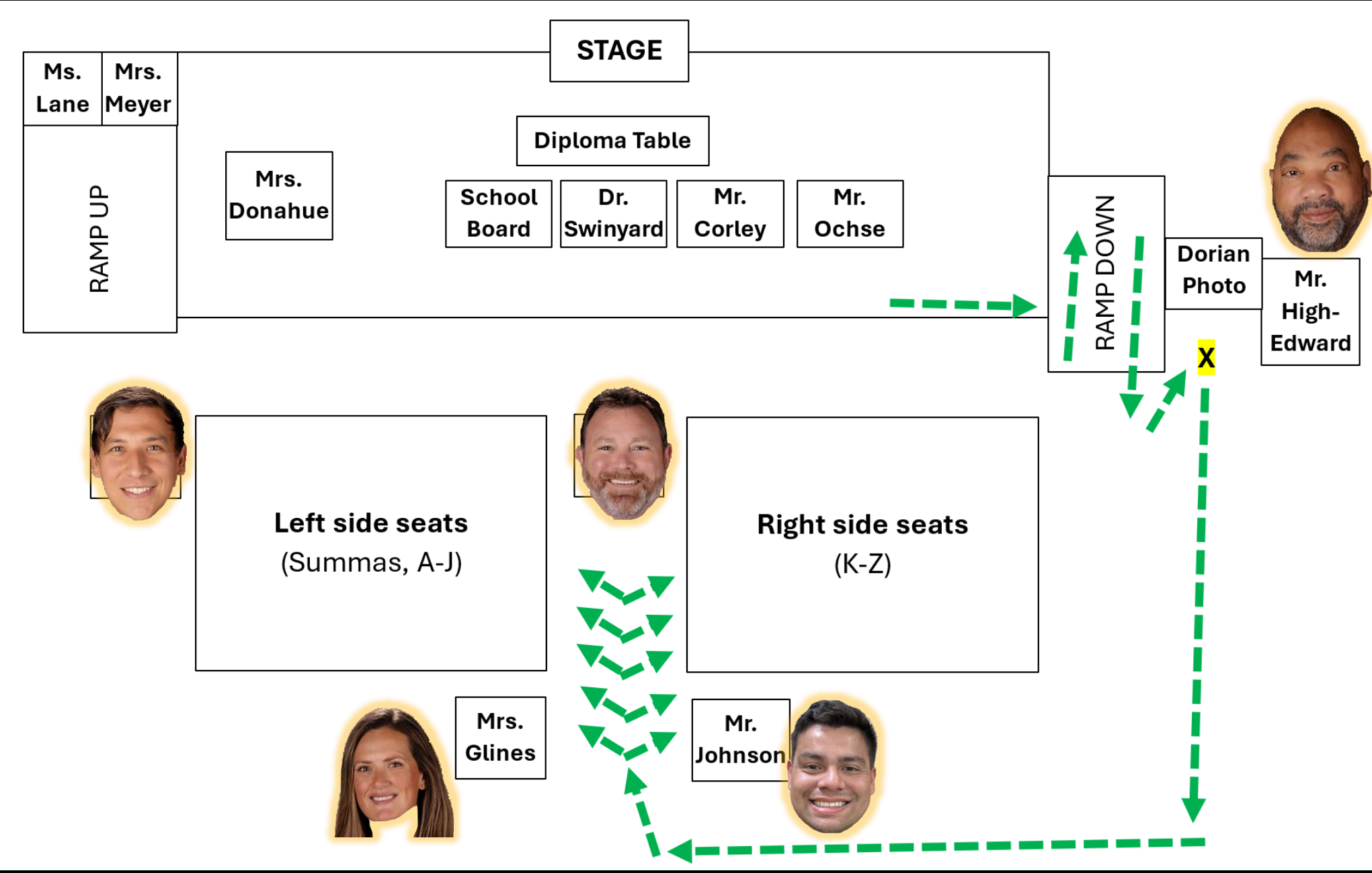
- When you are up on stage, it is important to:
 - Look out into the audience - your family wants to see your smiling face!
 - **Hand your card to the name reader (Mr. Corley - Summas or Mrs. Donahue - the rest of the class) .**
 - Start walking to the diploma table for the handshakes and diploma handoff.
 - Look back at your family and smile!
 - Continue walking off stage to the opposite ramp.
 - **Remember, this formal event is about your entire class.**
 - We have almost 400 students to go through the process, each student deserves to have their name read without distractions.

WE ARE ALMOST THERE!

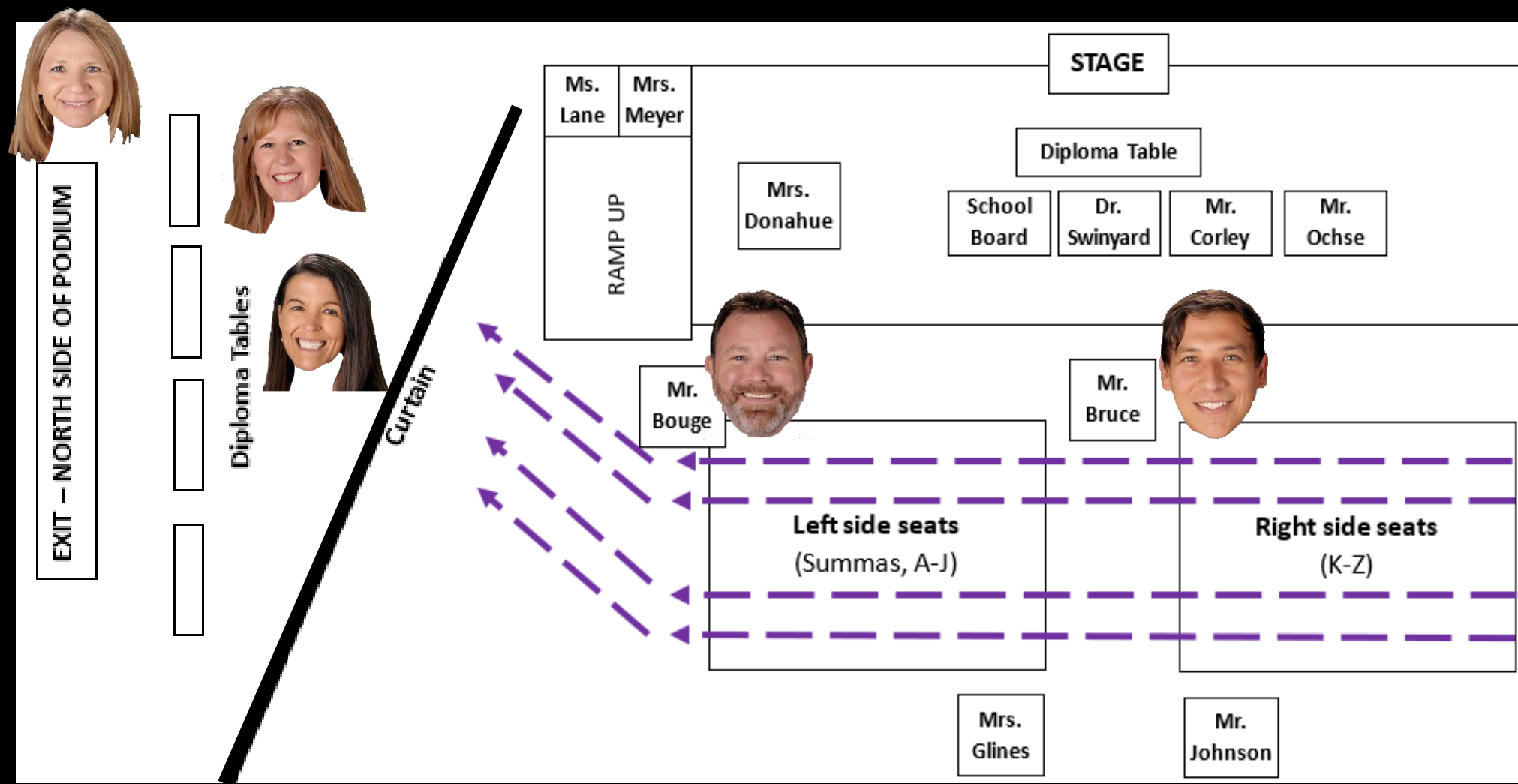
- Your row stays standing until the last student in your row returns. Sit in unison as directed.
- When the last graduate gets back to his/her seat, **Padmaja & Grace** will come from behind the table & take a position in front of the class & motion the entire class to stand.
- Once the class is standing, **Padmaja & Grace** will take hold of their tassels and direct you to move it from right to left (over your ❤️).



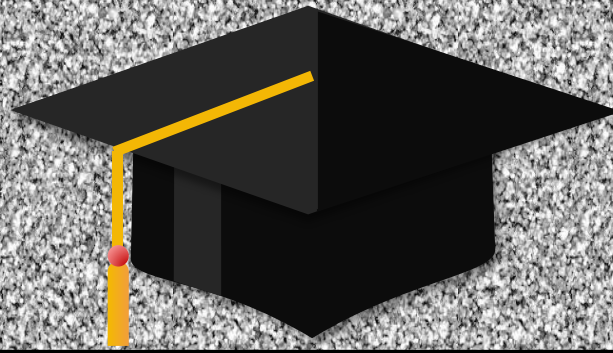
RECESSIONAL



- The Band/Orchestra will begin to play the recessional music (The LC Fight Song).
- Mr. Bruce and Mr. Bouge will begin directing each row to leave.
 - We leave in an orderly fashion, just like we entered.
- You will exit out behind the curtain to pick up your diploma (look for the letter that corresponds to your last name).
- You will then exit the Podium and meet up with your family.
- Have a plan where to meet your family - on the west side of the building at the Stadium or in Riverfront Park.
 - Don't have them meet you behind the Podium .

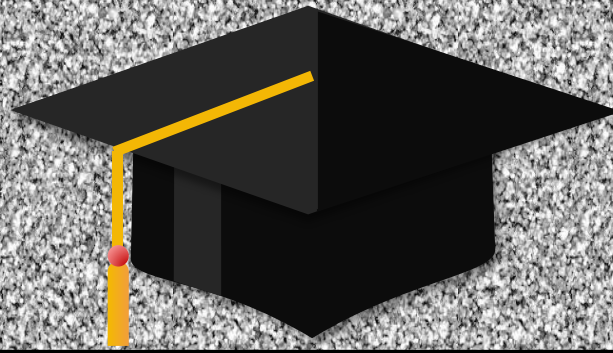
