**Dr. Daniel Spaite**

*Excellence in Prehospital Injury Care*

Dr. Daniel Spaite is a tenured professor and holds the Distinguished Chair of Emergency Medicine at the University of Arizona College of Medicine. He is a board-certified emergency physician and has been an EMS Medical Director for multiple fire departments and air medical transport programs over the last 25 years. He is the Director of EMS Research at the Arizona Emergency Medicine Research Center. Dr. Spaite has published more than 100 scientific articles and has presented his research on EMS, cardiac arrest, trauma systems, EMS outcomes analysis and EMS cost analysis at scores of conferences internationally. In 2010, he was awarded the Ronald Stewart, MD Career Award by the National Association of EMS Physicians.
