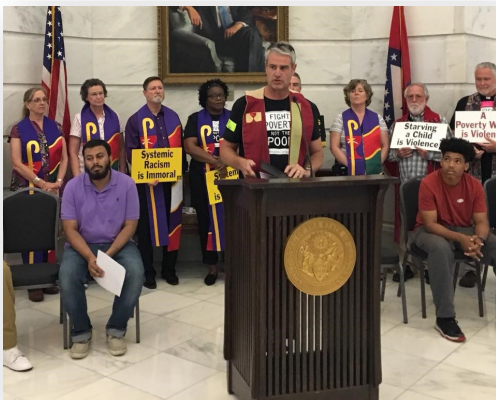
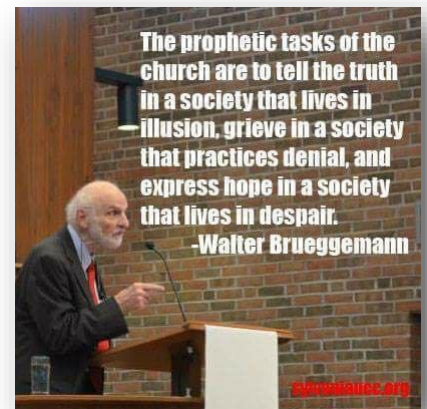
Prospective trainers must have completed the two and a half day Anti-Racism workshop given by Reconciliation Ministry in order to attend the three day Train the Trainer workshop. Both workshops will be held at the [Tall Oaks Conference Center](#) in Linwood, Kansas. Both satisfy requirements for renewing clergy standing.

Introduction to the Analysis of Racism

If we are ever to become an anti-racist/pro-reconciling church it is important that we know how to differentiate between systemic racism and personal bias. Systemic racism is deeply woven into the fabric of North American culture and the Church is not immune to its influence.

Learn how systemic racism operates, the violence it inflicts, and how power is used to keep it going to the advantage of the privileged. Participants will also explore ways to identify and challenge the operation of systemic racism within themselves, our Church, and in the communities we serve.
