At home, make use of the customary practices of prayer with continual perseverance. A beautiful death, the death of a God-fearing mother, and a beautiful eternity, a glorious crown await you."

Writing is a way that Redemptorists convey God's mercy and plentiful redemption. Our writing is known as our "apostolic of the pen." The Redemptorists of the Denver Province have promoted this for over a century through the *Liguorian* magazine and other books and pamphlets, and bulletins. Here's my story, or should I say miracle? My son, Kenny, was 12 when he was diagnosed with leukemia in 2007. When Kenny was born the doctors didn't expect him to live because he had heart problems which caused his esophagus not to grow and attach to his stomach. He had to have a feeding tube inserted the day he was born, at five months old he underwent open heart surgery, and three months later an esophagual atresia procedure attached his esophagus to his stomach.

At the age of five Kenny had an infection in his hip and was in a body cast for six weeks. After getting out of the cast he started kindergarten and things went back to normal for several years, till he turned 12 and was diagnosed with leukemia. When we were admitted to the hospital, the doctors told us they were going to start chemotherapy. All I could think of after all he's been through was, "Is he going to make it through this?"

Well, my husband and I went to the Seelos Center where a prayer partner prayed with us in the chapel. She also asked a Seelos blesser to come to the hospital and bless Kenny. Soon after that, the doctor said the cancer had disappeared but he wanted Kenny to finish treatment. After completing chemotherapy, we found out that it caused his esophagus to swell where it was attached to his stomach. This prevented food from going into his stomach.

The gastrointestinal doctor said Kenny was probably going to have to eat puréed food for the rest of his life. After we received that news, I called the Seelos Center again and the same blesser came to the hospital and prayed on Kenny with the crucifix of Father Seelos. My son was sleeping during the prayer, but when the blesser touched Kenny with the cross he lifted his head up, looked at the cross, and laid back down. It was very moving!! Later that night Kenny started eating, and has been eating normally ever since.

In my opinion, what we experienced was a miracle. I am a true believer and I know in my heart Blessed Father Seelos healed my son. Thank you, Blessed Seelos, for your intercession!

Amen.



Features a Seelos prayer card and a token with the inscription "This token is a reminder that you are being thought of and loved."




ST. PEREGRINE CANCER PRAYER KIT – \$16
