# Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos Institute announced

In Kansas City, KS at SHINE 2023, Donnelly College President Monsignor Stuart Swetland announced the launch of The Blessed Francis Xavier Seelos Institute for the Advancement of Catholic Education. The Institute aims to provide services to the local Catholic community by embracing two of Donnelly's core values: seeking truth and building community.

The Seelos Institute is named after Blessed Seelos, a German-born Redemptorist priest who dedicated his life to serving the poor and marginalized, with a special focus on immigrants and youth.

"As a Catholic College, Donnelly is called not just to provide education and faith formation to its students, but to engage the Church and the greater community in lifelong learning," Msgr. Swetland said. "With the creation of The Seelos Institute, the College will have a more formal structure for expanding these efforts."

One key initiative of The Seelos Institute provides ongoing faculty formation in elementary and secondary schools throughout the Archdiocese of Kansas City in Kansas – a service previously provided by Holy Family School of Faith. The staff responsible for this initiative are Sebastian D'Amico, Jennifer Punswick and Aaron Williams, Donnelly's former director of mission.

Two other initiatives are also underway: a partnership with the Ethics of Evidence Foundation to publish a series of scholarly works exploring the relationship between faith and science, and adult education including a monthly adult Bible study and business classes. More initiatives will be added as The Seelos Institute evolves.

#### STOCKTON, CA

Last year, my 93-year-old mother had to endure numerous hospital visits, intrusive medical procedures and was on several heart medications to treat pleural effusion, a condition in which the surrounding areas of both lungs filled with fluid. The doctors did not know why she was suffering from this dangerous condition. In January 2023, her health began to deteriorate. She was put on 24-hr oxygen, she was weak and could not walk. She was constantly out of breath and in extreme pain. She had to endure four lengthy hospital stays where she endured numerous intrusive procedures. My mother was declining in body and in Spirit.

When she relapsed for the fifth time, she was unable to breath even with the oxygen and was delirious and in constant pain. On May 5, 2023, she collapsed and it was at this time we believe a divine guidance spoke to us and told us to take her to another hospital. She was immediately admitted to a thoracic medical intensive care unit at a different hospital and was attended to by numerous teams of medical personnel. Throughout my mother's hospital stay, prayers were said to God, Blessed Seelos and other saints. Each day her medical condition improved, astonishing the medical staff.

After 11 days of intensive treatments, she was discharged. She is now in better health, has lost over 40 pounds and is no longer on 24/7 oxygen. She is walking again and does not take any of her numerous heart medications that she had been taking for over 20 years. My mother endured six thoracentesis which was unheard of for someone of her age. It is a risky procedure with dangerous consequences. It is a miracle that her lungs did not collapse and kill her. She has not had any recurrence.

My mother's strong Catholic faith guided her and helped her with a full recovery. She never lost faith and is a true living testament of the Power of Prayer. Our family would like to say a heartfelt Thank You to Jesus Christ our Savior and to Blessed Seelos for his intercession in her full recovery from this dangerous condition. Praise God. God is Good.

#### INDIANAPOLIS, IN

I was completely healed following praying a novena to Father Seelos which happened to end the day of my oldest son's first reconciliation.

I was recently injured in a car accident and the MRI showed complete tears which could only be repaired with surgery using knee connections from a deceased donor. I did not have the surgery, but I received full healing.

I was healed as I entered the confessional and the Lord allowed me to kneel without pain for the first time in over four months! I have had no pain at the sites since that healing.
