

### St. Michael, Warrior of God

Over the years, angels have been portrayed and presented in different forms. Many see these messengers of God as fluffy winged, halo-crowned youths or as the babyish cherubs often seen in old paintings and sculptures. People's interpretations of angels vary from guardians of children to the myth of the ringing of a bell giving an angel its wings. Overall, angels have become widely romanticized. What many people fail to notice, however, is that angels are the warriors of God. Sometimes they are described as fearsome beings, such as the Cherubim with four wings and heads, covered with eyes and flaming wheels about them, or the Seraphim sporting four wings and towering stature. It makes sense why they greet mortals with the phrase "Be not afraid"!

One of the best known of the angels is St. Michael the Archangel, the high prince and one of the principal angels. Michael was a great leader of the angels in the war against Satan and his followers. His name served as the war-cry of the good angels as they plunged into battle to "fight the dragon." The image of Michael defeating Satan is one of the most popular depictions of the archangel prince. He's often shown with a spear, sword, armor, banner, and/or scales.

Michael is known for his strength and courage, and many applaud him for his chivalry and determination to boldly fight for justice. He is featured more than any other named angel in religious texts, and is the oldest angelic devotion.

Michael is the leader of the four archangels. His fellow archangels are Raphael, whose special mission is healing, Gabriel, the announcing angel who came to the Virgin Mary, and Uriel, the angel of consolation who comforts mortals in times of great loss. Michael is charged with the tasks of protecting those who love God, transporting the souls of the dead, and leading the battle against Satan. He also is traditionally called upon for the freeing of those possessed by evil spirits.

Michael is the patron saint of the military, police officers, firefighters, death, and people who work in dangerous conditions. His feast day is celebrated on the 29th of September. St. Michael the Archangel has inspired artists, accompanied souls, and protected God's people throughout the ages as the leader of the angels and a true warrior of God.


# Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel

### GRACES RECEIVED & PRAYERS ANSWERED

Blessed Seelos has repeatedly answered prayer requests for my daughter, Tracy. Tracy was born with cerebral palsy due to a lack of oxygen at birth. When we went to the Seelos Shrine, the lady that prayed over her with the cross said "this child is perfect." I said, "I know, my real prayer is that God provide everything we need to take care of her."

God has answered Seelos' intercession! First, right after we got home from the Shrine, I received an email from a lady saying that she wanted to host a race to raise money for Tracy. The event raised \$1,800! Then, a friend who had retired from practicing law offered free services to create a trust fund for Tracy's donations. Tracy has gotten every piece of therapy equipment we have ever asked for, including a handicap accessible van and a gait trainer that her therapist had to write a 16-page letter for and send to Medicaid 15 times to get it approved because they had never approved that type of gait trainer before.

But by far the best answers to our prayers have been her physical healing. About five years ago Tracy sat up for the first time and since then, she has continued to improve to the point where she can sit for hours unassisted. In 2016 Tracy developed epilepsy and her seizures became so frequent that she had to have three times the dose of medication for her weight. She also had episodes where she quit breathing. We prayed fervently asking for Blessed Seelos' intercession and she has now been seizure-free for three years.

I could go on and on about the ways Blessed Seelos has intervened – these are just a few! She is the only level 5 quadriplegic cerebral palsy person that I know who has 100% cognitive function and can communicate! Her orthopedist says that if he had never met her, he couldn't tell from her X-rays that she has cerebral palsy, she has excellent bone structure! Praise the Lord for all His blessings.

This 5" resin ornament features a carved image of St. Michael conquering Satan - handmade in U.S. & comes with blue ribbon.




### ST. MICHAEL CANDLE – \$19
