Alabama Peanut Producers Association seeks National Peanut Board nominees during Alabama-Florida Peanut Trade Show

DOTHAN, ALABAMA – The Alabama Peanut Producers Association (APPA) is seeking eligible peanut producers interested in serving on the National Peanut Board. APPA will host its annual meeting and nominations for National Peanut Board during the Alabama-Florida Trade Show Jan. 29 at the National Peanut Festival Fairgrounds at 5622 Highway 231 S, Dothan, AL 36301.

The APPA annual meeting is at 11:15 a.m. in the Volunteer Building. All members are encouraged to participate.

APPA will hold a nominations election to select two nominees each for member and alternate to the National Peanut Board around 1 p.m. All eligible peanut producers are encouraged to participate. Eligible producers are those who are engaged in the production and sale of peanuts and who own or share the ownership and risk of loss of the crop.

Thomas Adams is the current Alabama National Peanut Board member, and Josh McCoy serves as alternate. Their terms expire Dec. 31, 2026.

The U.S. Department of Agriculture requires two nominees from each state for each position of member and alternate. The National Peanut Board will submit Alabama's slate of nominees to the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture, who makes the appointments.
