

Digital Photography and Film Teacher - part-time

The successful candidate will have experience teaching at the middle school level using Adobe, Photoshop, iMovie, iPads, and Nikon digital cameras. They will also understand the importance of process and differentiated instruction as they develop new skills and vocabulary in their students. We are a diverse community and seek to attract candidates who create curriculum that demonstrates respect for multiple perspectives.

Middle School Arts meets daily on a six-day cycle from 10:00-11:00 am and each class meets twice in that cycle. The role would include teaching every day from 10:00-11:00 am, as well as the appropriate preparation for each class.

Teaching Responsibilities:

Fall: Digital Photography and Documentary Film

Winter: Digital Photography, Documentary Film and Photoshop

Spring: Digital Photography, iMovie, and Claymation

Other Responsibilities include:

- Displaying and presenting student's work throughout the year, participating in our annual spring Arts assembly, and entering student's work in the Small Independent School Art League's annual juried show.
- Caring for and maintaining the appropriate equipment and studio spaces.
- Writing formal comments on their students at the conclusion of each term.
