



The participating members of FUMC, Clermont at the 2015 Mission u class: "Created for Happiness" returned with a definite **Call to Action** in mind before the mission study became a reality! Why not present the study in a form of a RETREAT and invite the women of other churches in the community to join us? The "Retreat" idea



was presented to the Leadership Team as an overnighter at the Florida United

Methodist Life Enrichment Center (LEC) in Fruitland Park, using the <u>Created for Happiness</u> text as the foundation for the agenda. There was an overwhelming "Let's do it!" Call to action before the actual study? God does work in mysterious ways!

A core committee was formed and ideas began to fly. Since a sizable financial, nonrefundable deposit was required to reserve rooms and meeting accommodations, the committee began small, thinking we could surely get 25 women to attend. Oh ye of little faith!

Under the leadership and enduring faith of Retreat Coordinator, Beth Knight, recent graduate of Asbury Theological Seminary with a Master's Degree in Pastoral Counseling, the core committee planned and implemented an exciting agenda, which included "running from rest," sacred liturgical dancers, praying with the body at the outdoor prayer labyrinth, relaxing lullaby yoga, mini presentations on "Created for Happiness, playful photo booth to capture the moment, etc. Invitational flyers were sent to local churches to join us May 20th for the Retreat.

How pleased we were that there were 49 at our very first RETREAT, which included participants from 5 other churches! Everyone went home with their own homemade finger prayer labyrinths to remember this very special occasion. Evaluations were very positive; wanting more and for longer. Already our United Methodist Women members are thinking "Climate Justice" might fit the bill for the 2017 Retreat. Oreta Haines Legacy

Oreta was a member of FUMC, Clermont for 62 years. For 50 years she was in charge of setting up for communion at the 8 AM service. You would see her in the church choir and performing with the hand bell choir. She organized a group at the church called SPARKS (Senior People Are Real Keen Servants.) She was a member of United Methodist Women for more than 40 years. During that time she and a friend organized summer luncheons when the United Methodist Women Circles were not meeting monthly. Oreta was an integral part of setting up and implementing the annual United Methodist Women rummage sale. With her seamstress skills she cut out bears, sewed front to back so other United Methodist Women members could stuff them and deliver to children in the local hospital. Oreta joined her Lord and Savior May 30, 2009. A few things have evolved somewhat over time: now the group is METS (Meeting, Eating, Traveling Seniors,) attendance at summer luncheons grown by leaps and bounds, Annual Holiday Bazaar rather than rummage sale and Christmas stockings for Dec. babies to go home in! Her servanthood philosophy aptly described in this poem she left for us. Thank you, Oreta, for paving the way for others in United Methodist Women to serve for the glory of the Lord.


