Responsibilities of Intern

- Fulfill the terms of the internship (assigned leadership role, tasks, work hours, etc.)
- Provide own transportation and meal costs, as well as any personal expenses

Responsibilities of Supervising Pastor/Minister

- Meet weekly with intern for supervision and reflection
- Provide intern with a wide variety of tasks in ministry
- Allow intern to have hands-on experience, with regular feedback in preaching, teaching, worship leadership, pastoral care, administration, and outreach/mission
- Support the intern's vocational discernment

Responsibilities of Host Site

- Provide adequate housing and utilities for intern's 10-week program
- Contribute \$1,500.00 to the intern's stipend

Responsibilities of Office of Clergy Excellence

- Contribute \$1,500.00 to the intern's stipend
- Train interns and supervisors before the program start date— Friday, May 26, 2017 from 10am to 3pm at the Conference Office in Lakeland.
- Lead a reflection day for interns at the conclusion of the program Monday, August 7, 2017 from 10am to 3pm at the Conference Office in Lakeland.
