CDC Receives SC Building Blocks Grant

"Childcare stabilization grants were appropriated to states in the American Rescue Plan Act to help stabilize the child care sector" negatively impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. "Funds must be used to support the key operating expenses of childcare providers to help ensure access to child care for families. In SC these stabilization grants are called 'SC Building Blocks'". This information comes from the scchildcare.org website.

Our CDC Director Becca Williams applied for one of these grants in January. As a result, the Saint Mark CDC was awarded a grant in the sum of \$220,750. 25% of the grant (\$55,000) must be spent on personnel/staffing. The remainder will be utilized to complete the modernization and repair of the interior and exterior of the CDC, including upgrading administrative software, implementation of the Fountas and Pinnell literacy program, updating curriculum and furnishings, and addressing playground drainage issues and additional new playground equipment. The CDC Steering Committee will continue working with Trustees on building and grounds issues and will engage with Family Ministry, Evangelism, and the Service and Missions teams for additional improvement opportunities. All of the funds must be utilized by September 30, 2023, and quarterly reporting of fund usage is required by DSS.

Thanks to Becca's diligence in securing this grant which will provide much needed benefits to our Center, Staff, and families!
