Who We Are

Women Veterans are currently one of the fastest growing patient populations across the Veterans Health Administration (VHA). By establishing a support learning program, we are meeting the needs of our population. In this program, women Veterans would educate newly and currently enrolled women Veterans about VA health services such as: Women's Care, Primary Care, Mental Health, TeleHealth, scheduling appointments, MyHealthvet, financial services and other services to include community care, disability claims, women's Veteran call center information and the Veteran's Crisis Line.

What Do We Do?

This program will aid and assist women Veterans when they present for appointments by being a "Sister Assister" and escorting them to appointments if requested to ensure the comfort and safety of the woman Veteran.

We will train women ambassadors to help educate, share experiences and connect newly enrolled and currently enrolled Veterans with VA and site-specific programs, resources and points of contact.

How do you get started?

- Be a woman Veteran enrolled in the Eastern Colorado Health Care System
- Contact the office of Center for Development & Civic Engagement (CDCE)
- Schedule an on-boarding interview with the intake coordinator
- Orientation
- Pair up with your Veteran
