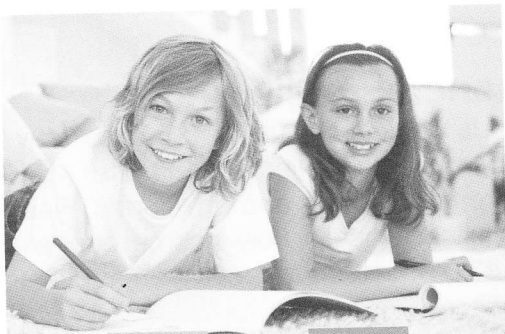

What is GRASP?

GRASP is an at-home program that helps students (Grades K-8) stay on top of math and language skills over the summer. The Language Arts program includes reading, spelling, grammar and phonics. The Math program includes basic math functions, fractions, percents, graphs, geometry and much more. Whether you are home for the summer or on the road, the convenient lessons go with you. This proven program has helped thousands of students retain critical skills.

How It Works

GRASP consists of nine fun, easy-to-use lessons. Complete one lesson a week at home and mail it to the teachers who review, score, and return them to you.
