2020 Natural Disasters

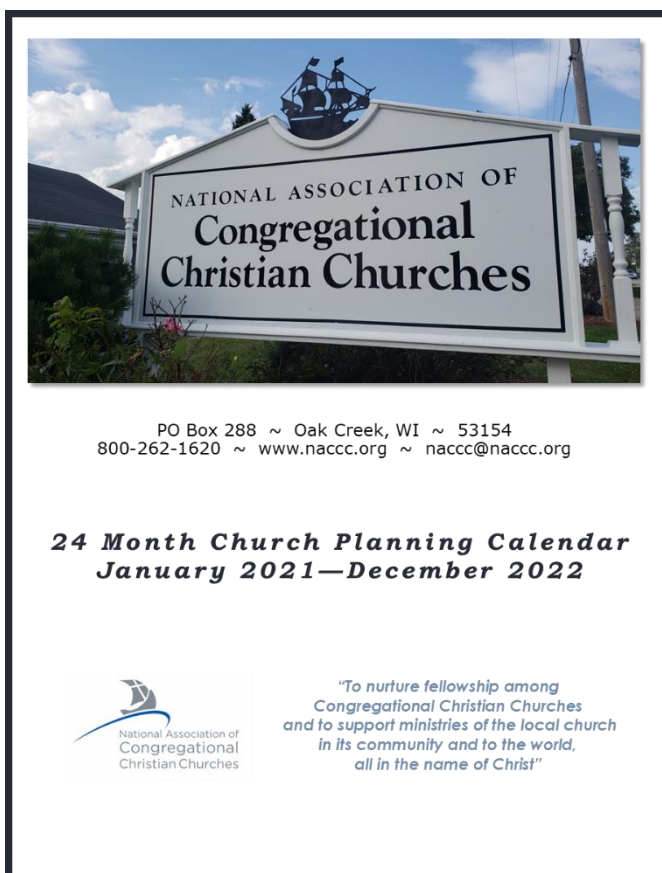
