The PWCDC Latino Caucus firmly opposes any efforts to revive the 287(g) agreement, which was discontinued in 2020 due to widespread concerns about civil rights violations, discriminatory enforcement, and costly legal challenges. Reinstating it would represent a dangerous step backward and undermine the values of inclusion and due process.

Attendees of the counter-protest are encouraged to bring signs, wear green as a symbol of unity, and submit public comments demanding humane, community-centered approaches to public safety.

We will not be silent while extremist agendas threaten the dignity and safety of our neighbors. We call on all people of conscience to stand with us in solidarity.
