Jay, his wife, Mavis, and their two sons live in Norfolk.

Jay is running for Attorney General in 2025 to protect Virginia families — from crime and violence, and from politicians with extreme agendas. He'll take on MAGA extremist Jason Miyares, who is failing to protect our families from the Trump Administration.

Jay previously served as an Assistant Attorney General in the Office of the Attorney General for the District of Columbia, where he was a member of the Office of Consumer Protection. In this role he took on gun manufacturers, financial institutions, and housing conglomerates to vindicate the rights of everyday citizens.

Jay also served in the House of Delegates, fighting to expand Medicaid, increase the minimum wage, give teachers annual pay raises, and protect a woman's right to choose.

The descendant of slaves and the grandson and son of pioneering civil rights activists, Jay sued the Youngkin Administration to protect the voting rights of all Virginians.

Jay is following in his family's footsteps in making Norfolk and the Commonwealth a better place. His grandfather Hilary H. Jones Sr. was a pioneering civil rights attorney in Norfolk and became the first Black member of both the Norfolk School Board and the State Board of Education. Jay's father was a lifelong public servant, and his mother continues to serve the community.

- **Supports a Virginia abortion ban** and laid the groundwork as AG to overturn Roe v. Wade
- **Opposed Medicaid expansion** and sides with Republicans in Washington who are taking health care away from 300,000 Virginians

- **Sided with Trump** and refused to protect Virginians from being illegally fired or to stop cuts to veterans' health care
