BSA Bankruptcy Update

In the last month, the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) sent legal packets regarding their bankruptcy case to local churches that have or are currently sponsoring troops. These documents are nontransparent and hard to decipher. The guidance anticipated from the denomination on how to proceed with the documents has been delayed, and we expect more information in the coming weeks. The church lay leadership, as comprised by the Administrative Council, and anyone else who is interested should take note of the following events:

Attend the Special Charge Conference of December 5, at 2:00 p.m. over Zoom: The General Council
on Finance and Administration (GCFA) of The United Methodist Church has determined that only a
church/charge conference can decide how the local church will vote on the BSA reorganization plan.
Therefore, we will be having a special church/charge conference on December 5 at 2:00 p.m. over
Zoom. At this special conference, we will determine how we will vote upon the BSA reorganization
