ABOUT THE PROGRAM



PARTICIPANTS WILL ENGAGE IN

- 2-day in-person Summer Leadership Development Institute from July 29 to July 30th
- Monthly cohort learning sessions throughout the year;
- Construction and leadership of an instructional change project at your school/site; and
- Ongoing partnership with a bilingual, school leader mentor throughout the year.



COMPENSATION

Participants who complete program requirements will receive \$32/hour stipend for time spent in session, paid monthly.



ALL PARTICIPANTS WELCOME

Participants do not have to be bilingual to apply. Those not bilingual will be able to participate in OPS sponsored Spanish language learning opportunities outside the program.
