

Impact of Medi-Cal (Medicaid) Cuts Fact Sheet



CA District 5 Rep. Tom McClintock (773,398 constituents)

1 in 3 (37%) of Rep. Tom McClintock's constituents would be harmed by cuts to Medicaid and other programs.

284,741 Rep. McClintock's constituents in District 5 would be severely impacted by cuts to Medicaid and other programs, this includes:

- 239,374 health coverage for workers, people with disabilities, children, and seniors (Medi-Cal)
- 76,583 getting food (Cal-Fresh)
- 34,469 working people with Covered California health insurance
- 18,117 new mothers getting formula and other help (WIC)
- 10,162 people receiving support to live in their home (IHSS)
- 6,482 people with developmental disabilities (regional centers)
- 1,041 foster youth
