

Impact of Medi-Cal (Medicaid) Cuts Fact Sheet



CA District 40 Rep. Young Kim (755,867 constituents)

1 in 4 (29%) of Rep. Kim's constituents would be harmed by cuts to Medicaid and other programs.

219,924 Rep. Kim constituents in District 40 would be severely impacted by cuts to Medicaid and other programs, this includes:

- 162,484 health coverage for workers, people with disabilities, children, and seniors (Medi-Cal)
- 166,576 getting food (Cal-Fresh)
- 53,438 new mothers getting formula and other help (WIC)
- 41,310 with Covered California health insurance
- 16,466 people receiving support to live in their home (IHSS)
- 8,424 people with developmental disabilities (regional centers)
- 2,896 foster youth
