A face-to-face visit with your state Assemblymember and Senator and/or their staff is an opportunity for you to discuss issues that are important to you. This is why we strongly encourage you to make appointments with your legislators in their Capitol offices as soon as you have registered for our conference.

The Arc & UCP California Collaborative Lobby Day is Wednesday, March 20, 2019. It is best to call 3 -4 weeks in advance to ensure that you will get an appointment. When you call your Assemblymember and Senator's Capitol offices let the scheduler know you are a constituent from the district visiting Sacramento and you would like to schedule a meeting to talk about issues in the intellectual and developmental disabilities community that are important to you.
