

Impact of Medi-Cal (Medicaid) Cuts Fact Sheet



CA District 41 Rep. Ken Calvert (881,664 constituents)

1 in 3 (35%) of Rep. Calvert's constituents would be harmed by cuts to Medicaid and other programs.

308,877 Rep. Calvert constituents in District 41 would be severely impacted by cuts to Medicaid and other programs, this includes:

- 259,615 health coverage for workers, people with disabilities, children, and seniors (Medi-Cal)
- 121,080 getting food (Cal-Fresh)
- 40,806 new mothers getting formula and other help (WIC)
- 33,060 with health insurance (Covered California)
- 15,017 people receiving support to live in their home (IHSS)
- 7,134 people with developmental disabilities (regional centers)
- 1,695 foster youth

- Palm Springs, Rancho Mirage, Palm Desert, Indian Wells, and La Quinta

The district then stretches through the sparsely inhabited regions of the San Jacinto Mountains before taking in the Corona, Norco, Lake Elsinore, Canyon Lake, and portions of Eastvale.

The edges of the district also stretch further south to take in portions of the Perris and Temecula Valleys, such as Lake Elsinore, Menifee, Wildomar, and small portions of Murrieta.
