

Impact of Medi-Cal (Medicaid) Cuts Fact Sheet

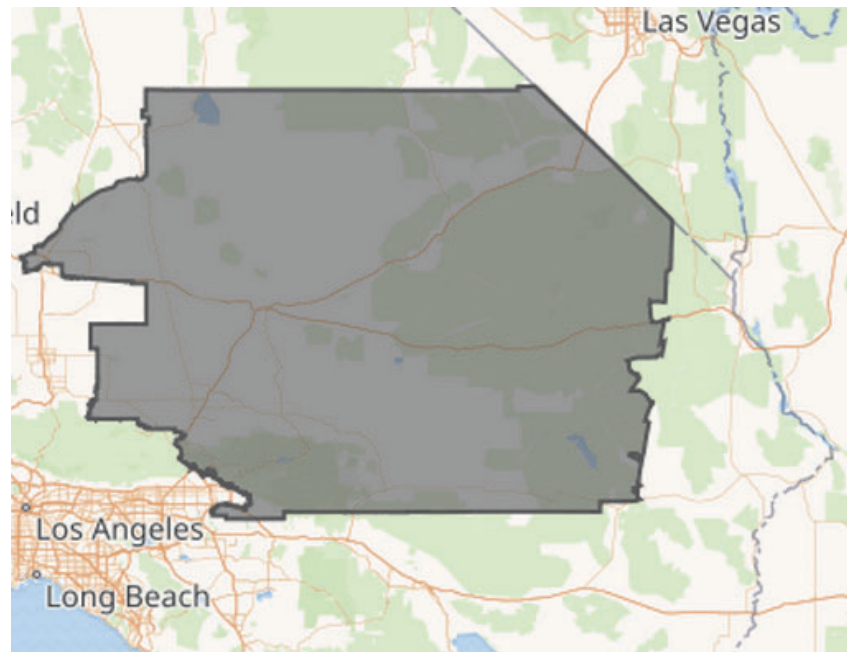

CA District 23 Rep. Jay Obernolte (768,047 constituents)

1 in 2 (53%) of Rep. Obernolte constituents would be harmed by cuts to Medicaid and other programs.

408,320 Rep. Obernolte constituents in District 23 would be severely impacted by cuts to Medicaid and other programs, this includes:

- 371,162 health coverage for workers, people with disabilities, children, and seniors (Medi-Cal)
- 173,419 getting food (Cal-Fresh)
- 42,373 new mothers getting formula and other help (WIC)
- 21,070 with Covered California health insurance
- 10,500 people receiving support to live in their home (IHSS)
- 9,497 people with developmental disabilities (regional centers)
- 2,790 foster youth
