

# Impact of Medi-Cal (Medicaid) Cuts Fact Sheet

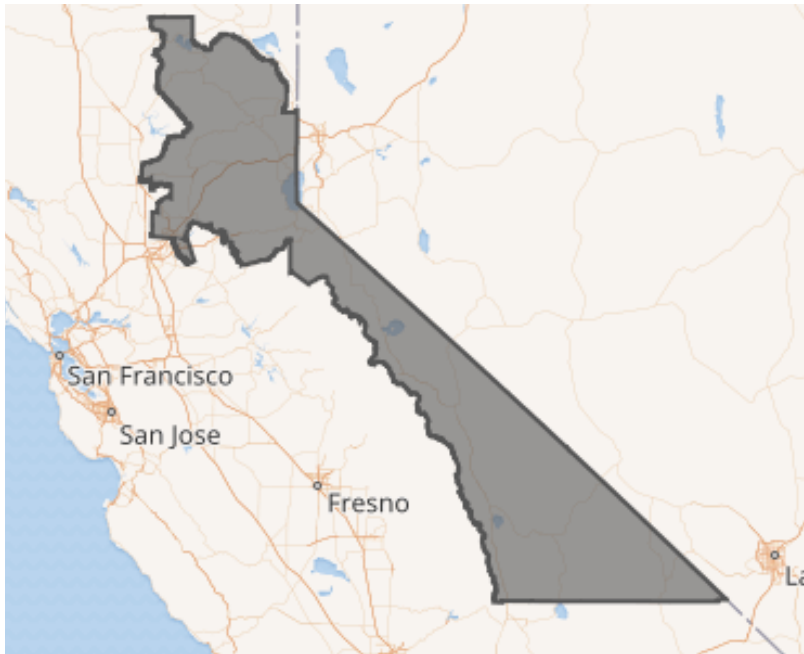

**CA District 3 Rep. Kevin Kiley (768,419 constituents)**

**3 in 10 (30%) of Rep. Kevin Kiley's constituents would be harmed by cuts to Medicaid and other programs.**

228,363 Rep. Kiley's constituents in District 3 would be severely impacted by cuts to Medicaid and other programs, this includes:

- 174,034 health coverage for workers, people with disabilities, children, and seniors (Medi-Cal)
- 109,157 getting food (Cal-Fresh)
- 40,710 working people with Covered California health insurance
- 27,183 new mothers getting formula and other help (WIC)
- 10,903 people receiving support to live in their home (IHSS)
- 7,389 people with developmental disabilities (regional centers)
- 1,521 foster youth
