All: **It is right and just.**

Fr. Crispin: ...and with one voice, we acclaim.

All: **Holy, holy, holy Lord
God of hosts,
Heaven and earth are full of your

Blessed is he who
comes in the name of the Lord.
Hosanna in the highest.**
