


Come for a delicious meal of freshly battered fried fish, chips, coleslaw, and this year we're adding clam chowder too!

**ORGAN RECITAL**




Let's come together for a captivating Organ Recital on **Good Friday, April 18, 2025, 3:00 PM** at St. Benedict Catholic Church.

Many of you have heard this program in years past, it will be a joy to have it here again this year!


# MORE EVENTS

All are welcomed to pray for vocations or to discern them, so invite someone you know who might be willing to discern a vocation one day to the priesthood or religious life!


