WestSide Baby meets the basic needs of children to promote safety, security, and healthy development. They provide essentials to those in need by collecting and distributing diapers, clothing, and equipment throughout King County. These are the most needed donation items currently:

1. Hygiene items (especially baby wash, shampoo for 3 years and older, and dental care items for infants-12 years old)
2. New and gently used clothing (especially for sizes 3t-5t, boy and girl)
3. New underwear for boys and girls (especially 4t/5t, 6, 7/8, 10/12, 14/16)
4. Socks for older kids
5. Pajamas (all sizes and genders)
6. Toys and stuffed animals
7. Books (especially board books)
8. Diapers and wipes (especially size 5 and 6)
9. Pull-Ups (all sizes and genders)
10. Raincoats and rain boots (especially for toddler sizes)
