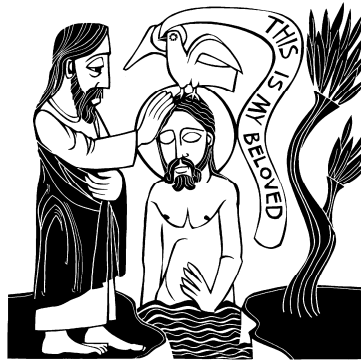

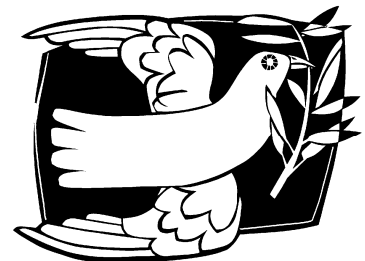
**Apostles Creed**
