God heavenly King, O God, almighty Father.

SIDE B: [Sacred Heart side] Lord, Jesus Christ, Only
Begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father,
you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us, you
take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are
seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

ALL: For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are
the Lord, you alone are the Most high,
Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit,
in the Glory of God the Father.

ALLELUIA --INSTRUMENTAL

GOSPEL *A reading from the book of Matthew,
Mark, Luke or John.*

HOMILY

We learn about the meaning of the readings.

PRAYER OF THE FAITHFUL

All: Lord, hear our prayer

LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

*The special prayer of the liturgy which is
the highlight of the Mass. The bread and
wine are transformed into the body and
blood of Christ.*

PREPARATION OF GIFTS-cantor solo

Lead Me Lord

Blessed are the poor in spirit,

longing for their Lord,

for God's coming kingdom shall be theirs.

Blessed are the sorrowing,

for they shall be consoled,

and the meek shall come to rule the world.

Refrain: Lead me, Lord, lead me, Lord,

by the light of truth

to seek and to find the narrow way.

Be my way; be my truth;

be my life, my Lord,

and lead me, Lord, today.

All: *Father blesses the bread and wine, then we say...*

Blessed be God forever.

Fr. Crispin: Pray, my dear friends, that my
sacrifice and yours may be acceptable to
God, the almighty Father.

-Stand-

All: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands, for the
praise and glory of his name, for our good, and the good of
all his holy Church.

EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

Eucharist means "Thanksgiving."

Fr. Crispin: The Lord be with you.

All: And with your spirit.

Fr. Crispin: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them up to the Lord.

Fr. Crispin: Let us give thanks to the Lord, our God.

All: It is right and just

Father Crispin continues the Eucharistic prayer. Then he invites us to exclaim:

All: Holy, holy, holy Lord God of hosts,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who
comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the
highest.

-Kneel-

Fr. Crispin: *Father continues the prayer and then he says . . .*
Let us proclaim the mystery of faith.

All: When we eat this Bread and drink this Cup, we
proclaim your death, O Lord, until you come again.

Fr. Crispin: *Father continues the prayer and then he says*
. . . all glory and honor is yours forever and ever.

All: Amen!

-stand-

OUR FATHER

All: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy
name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth
as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread;
and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those
who trespass against us; and lead us not into
temptation, but deliver us from evil.

...For the kingdom, the power, and the glory are
yours, now and forever.

SIGN OF PEACE

We extend a gesture of peace: handshake or embrace.

THE LAMB OF GOD

All: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the
world: have mercy on us.

COMMUNION

Fr. Crispin: Behold the Lamb of God, behold
him who takes away the sins of the world.
Blessed are those called to the supper of the
Lamb.

All: Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under
my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be
healed.
