

## **Physician-Scientist Training Program**

## Call for Nominations | 2025

The Physician-Scientist Training Program exists to provide research-oriented residents, fellows, and junior faculty the opportunity to further develop careers in biomedical research. The purpose and goal of this program is to not only help alleviate the critical shortage of physician-scientists in this country, but it is also designed to recruit and retain physician-scientists that will become productive faculty members at UNMC. This award totals \$200,000, which is comprised of a two-year salary plus benefits award of \$75,000 per year, plus \$25,000 per year for supplies/operating expenses.

The program is targeted to individuals either recently (< 3years) hired on as faculty or as part of a recruitment package activated when they begin their appointment. There will be one slot available for the current fiscal year. Interested candidates should **include in the application**: their CV and a document of up to four pages with a brief description of their previous research, a statement of their current research goals, and their plan to achieve independent funding. In addition to the application materials, the applicant's Department Chair and/or Division Chief should provide a letter of nomination that discusses the protected time they will provide to accommodate for the applicant's research. Applications will be scored on the applicant's previous research experience and productivity, the likelihood that the proposed research project will lead to a competitive, external funding application, and the potential of the applicant to continue as a successful and productive physician scientist at UNMC.
