Flu vaccines are required.

WHO: All VCUHS team members and volunteers

WHAT: All team members and volunteers must receive flu vaccine

HOW:

1. Fast track clinic for team members and volunteers held in the Main 2 Meeting Center:

- Free
- On-site
- No need to submit documentation
- Injection only

Monday, October 8	1—7 p.m.
Tuesday, October 9	7:30 a.m.—2 p.m.
Wednesday, October 10	12 noon—7 p.m.
Thursday, October 11	7:30 a.m.—5 p.m.
Friday, October 12	12 noon—5 p.m.

2. In the community:

- Out-of-pocket fee may be charged
- Off-site
- Submit documentation to HR4U
- Injection of mist

Team members who receive nasal mist may not work on any unit with immuno-suppressed patients (e.g., PICU, MRICU and BMT) for seven days post-vaccine.

3. After fast track, vaccine will be available in EHS and by peer vaccinators starting October 16.
