To the families of 11th and 12th graders,

During the week of October 5th, BTWHSPVA will transition to a hybrid learning model. As part of this new arrangement of our schedule, we are excited to welcome our 11th and 12th grade in-person learners to campus on **Thursday, October 8th**. Beginning this week, juniors and seniors will attend their academic classes virtually on Monday and Tuesday. Those students who have elected to attend in-person will come to campus on Thursday and Friday for their in-person art classes. Wednesdays will be an asynchronous learning day for students to check in with their teachers.

Regardless of your mode of learning (in-person or remote learner), the time schedule will change next week based on the days of the week. You will still have the same classes; however, they are grouped differently by day:

Designated Entrance/Exit: On Thursday and Friday, please remember your conservatory's assigned entrance and exit:

Dance: Student Entrance near the Faculty Lot

Theater: Visitor Entrance near the Circle Drive off of Routh Street

Visual Arts: Historic Entrance off of Flora Street

Music: Montgomery Arts Theater Lobby off of Jack Evans Street

Parking: The senior parking lot (Lexus Silver Garage) will be open on Thursday, October 8th for Seniors. The J-Lot under Woodall-Rogers will be available for juniors. We will be selling parking passes for \$25 (please remember to bring your license and proof of insurance). You must have a hangtag no later than Thursday, October 22nd or risk being towed.

Seniors: You have the option of parking in either lot, due to the fact that you will be required to use your designated entrance listed above.

Safety Requirements: You must wear a mask from the time you enter campus until the time you leave. Bus riders must wear their mask while on the bus. The mask must be worn properly over your mouth and nose. We must be 100% compliant with this rule for your safety and the safety of others. If you haven't already received them, each student will receive three reusable BTW masks, a bottle of hand sanitizer, an optional face shield, and a personal plexiglass tri-fold divider (which will be used and kept at school). All on-campus students will eat breakfast and lunch with their FLEX groups in their designated classroom. Remember – school breakfast and lunch are free for all students. Sanitize your hands often throughout the day. Social distancing rules will be in effect in classrooms, hallways, and outdoor locations at all times.

Your FLEX teachers should have reviewed all of this information with you; however, I know it is good to see it on paper.

Juniors: We will be meeting virtually in FLEX on Tuesday, October 9th at 9 AM for your **junior class assembly**.

Reminder: if you elected to be in-person, your on-campus days are **Thursday and Friday**.

Please remember our vision statement – *We are an intersection of innovation and creation. We are a home for the young artists and thinkers that will write the next chapter of our society.* Our BTW community has been innovative and creative with our schedule to maximize your arts learning while preserving the strong academic foundation we have built. Our approach may be different, but I know that our creative revolutionaries will continue to amaze us with their determination. We look forward to seeing all of our in-person 11th and 12th graders in their FLEX at 9 AM on **Thursday** morning!
