This year, the Church of the Common Ground is asking for donations of:

- diabetic socks only (no regular socks) OR...
- \$ cash donations \$ and we will buy socks for you

We've made it REALLY easy for you:

- Click → St. Bede's Amazon Wish List.
- 2. You can either buy from Amazon or **print the list** and take it to your favorite online or local retailer.
- 3. If you are ordering online, have the socks delivered to your home.
- 4. Bring the socks to church, and put them in the collection bin! Done!

Important things to remember:

- 1. Collection bins will be available in the church Commons from September 8 29.
- 2. Please do not have socks mailed to the church. Delivieries often miss our office hours.
- 3. No regular socks, please.

The Church of the Common Ground provides support for the pastoral needs of people who live on the margins of our city, including many of Atlanta's homeless population. These donations will help support the needs of the Common Soles foot clinic.
