Puerto Rico QuakeSmart Agenda Announced

Business, nonprofit, and emergency communities will come together on August 28 in Dorado, Puerto Rico for a free [QuakeSmart Preparedness Workshop](#) presented by FLASH and Founding & Legacy Partner FEMA. Studies have shown that three years after a natural disaster impact, 75% of businesses without a continuity plan will fail.

The workshop shares *QuakeSmart* protocols that can reduce damage costs, save lives, and help communities recover more quickly following seismic disasters. Attendees will:

- Learn about business continuity, disaster response, and the cost benefit of preparing for earthquakes and other business interruptions;
- Identify preparedness and mitigation actions needed to ensure safety and business continuity;
- Complete assessments and begin planning for retrofit projects; and,
- Learn how to perform preparedness and mitigation activities using the *QuakeSmart Community Resilience Program*.
