South Carolina Training Partnership Tradition Continues

SVP Mike Rimoldi joined the South Carolina Department of Insurance in Charleston to conduct SC Safe Home Program training for new contractors and inspectors in Charleston on May 22 – 23, continuing more than a decade of collaboration between the organizations.

The program detailed how retrofits apply to the building code and included information on how homeowners along the coast of South Carolina can apply for matching grants to strengthen their home against hurricane and high-wind damage.

“The SC Safe Home program has been helping coastal residents strengthen and protect their homes against severe storms and hurricanes for more than ten years. We have worked with more than 5,000 homeowners to help them retrofit their homes and learn the importance of mitigation,” said Ann Roberson Public Information Officer, SC Department of Insurance. “This would not be possible without our partnership with the contractors and inspectors with the SC Safe Home program. The education and training that FLASH provides our contractors and inspectors ensure that the SC Safe Home program is providing the most up-to-date mitigation techniques and practices available.”
