Whether you are paying attention to politics or not, YOUR vote is extremely important to affect the change we demand. Do not wait for election day to cast your vote. If possible, take your ballot to the Ventura County Office of Elections and drop it off in person, or ask Move The Needle to pick it up and take it down for you.

There are numerous principles we use to recommend who and what to vote for (or against). A few fundamental positions include:

- Californian's taxes are too high and any request for a bond or to raise taxes is not acceptable.
- Lawmakers are working to address the extreme minority issues at the expense of all.
- Public school system is one of the worst in the country. They have become indoctrinators instead of educators.
- Candidates must support the U.S. Constitution as the rule of law
- The biggest threat is not climate control.
- Major issues include invasion of illegal immigrants and freedom of speech
