Parent:

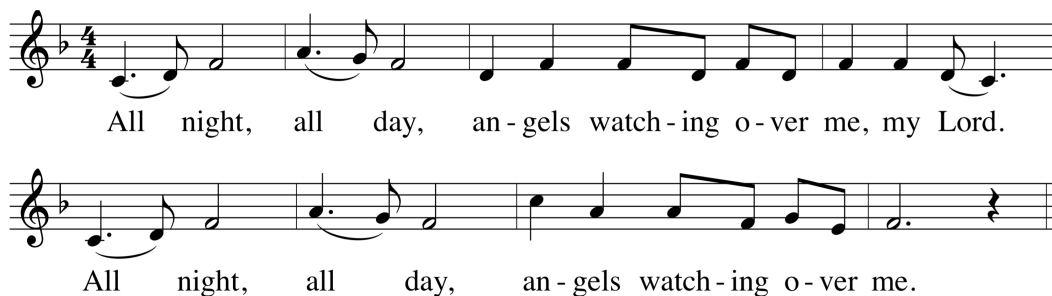
