Developing spiritual leadership

The SLDI is based on John Scherer's ground-breaking spiritual development principle: 'You don't need to change yourself. You need to come home to your Self. This changes everything.'

And how do we 'come home to ourselves'? These Five Questions are a good place to start. (How would <u>you</u> answer them?)

Question #1: What's CONFRONTING me? What 'tigers' do I need to face? (Difficult decisions or people or situations that are pulling on me for action.)

Question #2: What am I BRINGING?

My hopes, my fears, my history with this kind of 'tiger', my internal conversation that sees what is happening as a 'tiger'.

Question #3: What's been RUNNING me? How am I on 'automatic'? What is my 'default' that I am relying on? What are habits of thinking, feeling, seeing and doing that 'run' me now?

Question #4: What CALLS me?
From inside: What charisms live in me that call out to be expressed even more in my life and work?
From outside: What kind of life situations am I perfectly 'designed' to address? What called me into this work at the beginning? What is calling out to me now?

Question #5: What will UNLEASH me? How will I 'operationalize' (put into praxis) what I have seen or learned in this Spiritual/leadership development exploration?

Rev. Dr. John J. Scherer

Rev. Dr. John J. Scherer, SLDI 'Dean', has led individual leadership and large-scale change initiatives with some of the world's largest organizations for over five decades. Since 1987, when he created the first version of what is now called 'The Leadership Development Intensive', men and women leaders — and their life partners — from 55 countries have graduated. His 2020 book, 'Facing the Tiger: Unleashing the Human Spirit at Work' has been called 'The best business self-help book ever written', and his 2010 graduation address at Roanoke College was selected by NPR for their list of the 'The Best 100 Commencement Speeches in America. Ever.' An ordained ELCA Pastor, prior to beginning his leadership development and change work with organizations in 1973, John served as Lutheran Chaplain at Cornell University and Senior Pastor of The Lutheran Church in Ithaca.



Rev. Dr. David Galloway

Rev. Dr. David Galloway is an Episcopal priest who led parishes for thirty years. With a life-long passion for the development of ministers, he served as the Assistant to the Director of the Center for Faith Development at Emory University; as designer of the Pilgrimage Project for Candler's Continuing Education Center; as the Chairperson of the Commission on Ministry for the Diocese of Atlanta; and as diocesan Canon for the Bishop of Texas. David also has led graduating seminarians through the transition and training for their first year in parish ministry. He currently coaches ministers across all traditions in their practice of leadership. His blog www.southofgod.com is widely followed by spiritual 'seekers' around the world.

This engagement transformed how we interacted, lead and conducted ourselves. Terry has subsequently attended and/or assisted with 6 LDIs. His professional work following the above roles has consisted of working in the elder care field, being CEO of a foundation which measured medical clinical quality and outcomes and 20 years as a medical director of a large drug and alcohol treatment program, where he still sees patients a few days each month. Spare time now is spent walking his dog, working on his old cars, playing Dixieland jazz and doing serious portrait photography.



David (AGAPE) Scherer combines rapping, dancing, and storytelling to translate the depth of his theological training into songs and stories that communicate with listeners in profound ways. In 2009, he received the ELCA's Tom Hunstad Award for Excellence in Youth Ministry. David is co-founder of JUMP (Joint Urban Ministries in Praise), which is dedicated to helping urban youth unleash their leadership skills. His work was also featured in an ABC documentary, 'Peace of Bread' about food insecurity in America. In 2018 he and Joe Davis co-created 'Next Faithful Move', a process for awakening people of all races to the need for authentic understanding, connection and respect.
